



## 2023-24 School Year Homeschool Enrichment Learning Program (HELP)

**The goal of the Lake Center Christian School HELP Program is to assist Christian families who have prayerfully decided to homeschool their students by offering students the opportunity for spiritual, social and academic interaction with Lake Center students in an environment that values a biblical worldview.**

**Registration Process:** Registration procedures and annual registration fee are required for all students participating in the Home Enrichment Learning Program (HELP). The enrollment fee for 2022-2023 is \$225 plus \$25 online application fee for new students. There are additional fees required for specific activities and classes. Actual meeting days or times may change subject to the Lake Center Christian School 2023-2024 schedules. Families are responsible to check electronic school communications for changes as they occur.

**Students in the Lake Center Christian School HELP Program are not considered enrolled as LCCS students, and therefore are not eligible for the EdChoice or Jon Peterson Scholarships.** Parents are responsible for fulfilling the requirements of the Homeschooling Laws in Ohio by registering with their local school district superintendent. Lake Center Christian School requests a copy of that notification and a copy of the letter of compliance issued by the superintendent of the district of residence at the time a student registers in the HELP Program.

*According to Ohio State Homeschooling Law, Parents agree to:*

1. *Provide 900 hours of instruction per year;*
2. *Notify the superintendent every year*
3. *Provide an assessment of the student's work*

### **Homeschool Enrichment Learning Program Opportunities:**

#### **Junior High (7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> Grades)**

- **Up to 3 classes** where openings exist \$1,267 plus a \$125 operations fee per 2 semester class
- **Band** Three times per week \$780
- **Choir** Three times per week \$780
- **Orchestra** Three times per week \$780
- **Private Music Lessons** \$18.00/half hour session weekly as there are openings
- **Chess Club** Weekly /Wednesdays from 2:45-4:00 Fee + registration fee TBD to participate in tournaments
- **Art Club** Once per month \$50 for year
- **Ski Club** Saturdays during winter months \$TBA based on Slope Rates – No transportation provided
- **ACSI Events** with registration for at least one class according to ACSI rules - \$10 per event

#### **High School (9<sup>th</sup> -12<sup>th</sup> Grades)**

- **Up to 3 classes** where openings exist - \$1,602 plus a \$125 operations fee per 2 semester class – some additional fees may apply for materials
- **Band**-daily \$1,602
- **Choir**-daily \$1,602
- **Orchestra**-daily \$1,602
- **Private Music Lessons** \$18.00/half hour session weekly as there are openings
- **Art Club** – Once per month \$50 per year
- **Ski Club** Saturdays during winter months \$TBA based on Slope Rates – No transportation provided
- **ACSI Events** – With enrollment in class according to ACSI rules - \$10

**Junior High and High School students must take at least 3 classes to be eligible to participate in sports or theatrical productions.**

**At least one of the three classes needs to be Bible, Math, Science, Social Studies, or English Language Arts.**

### **Additional benefits for all students:**

1. Access to the school library or study hall during scheduled open periods with Principal approval
2. Invitation to attend all chapel programs, school assemblies, and school events open to the community
3. Participation in standardized testing with \$25 testing materials fee on school scheduled testing dates
4. Individual school photos – packages available to order
5. Opportunity to purchase lunch if on campus during lunch periods
6. Field trips *for registered classes*
7. Use of academic material *for registered classes*
8. FACTS account for information on class and school events
9. Participation in additional club opportunities as they are developed

### **Policies:**

1. Required study hall or lunch placement if on campus but not in a scheduled class
2. Classes will be offered at the regularly scheduled times as for full-time LCCS students
3. Classes will be on an audit basis with grade report of work completed provided to parents
4. All academic guidance services are the parent's responsibility

## **Annual Tuition for Part-time Students Registered for HELP**

HELP students in grades 7-12 are eligible to register for classes at Lake Center Christian School as openings exist. **HELP students will be allowed to apply for openings after enrollment of full-time students has been completed.** The tuition schedule for the HELP is for 1 individual student for an academic school year per academic credit. **HELP student registration deadline is August 1. A year commitment is required.** There are no multiple student discounts. Registration fees are based on the published cost of tuition for classes.
