2023-2024 School Year

Dear Tuition Assistance Applicants:

Lake Center Christian School distributes a limited amount of funds each school year to help families who cannot afford the full price of tuition for their child(ren) to attend the school. These funds have been provided by grants; donations made in memory of Ernest Weaver, Herman Weaver, Howard Miller, Peggy Hartman, and Kenneth Lockwood; and through other donors who have a desire to see as many children benefit from a Christian education as possible.

<u>FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment Service</u> will be conducting the financial need analysis for the 2023-24 school year. Families applying for tuition assistance will need to complete an online application and submit the necessary supporting documentation to FACTS. **Your application will not be processed if any documentation is missing.** You do not need to fill in next year's tuition. We will submit that information to FACTS. A supplemental application form (enclosed) **must** also be filled out and returned to the LCCS business office.

As you submit your applications for tuition assistance, please take the following into consideration:

- All information submitted is considered to be extremely confidential and will only be discussed within the setting of the Tuition Assistance Committee.
- The funds available for distribution each year are limited and may vary from year to year. Funds will be made available to those who qualify on a percentage basis, but it will be no higher than 50% if tuition. Fees are not eligible for tuition assistance.
- ◆ Tuition Assistance <u>must</u> be applied for every year.
- Your tuition payments must be current and your student commitment fee(s) for 2023-24 must be paid. If you decide not to send your child(ren), you have 2 weeks after you receive the tuition assistance award letter to notify the school and we will refund your student commitment fee(s).
- Information on ability to pay that is determined through FACTS will be used solely as a guideline for the LCCS Tuition Assistance Committee in determining the actual amount of assistance to be granted.
- You will be giving information on both applications that is similar or identical in some cases. Both applications must be <u>filled out completely</u> in order to be considered.
- The deadline to apply is April 17th to be considered for tuition assistance.

Our goal is to process information received in a timely manner. You will be informed through a letter regarding the status of your application by mid-June. If you have any questions, please contact the LCCS Business Manager or Superintendent.

<u>After</u> you submit your application, the application summary will display the documents you need to upload to complete your application.

Information to know/have ready to complete Grant & Aid application for Parents:

- 1. There is a one-time non-refundable application fee of \$40 per household. The same application can be applied to multiple institutions, provided they use the FACTS Grant & Aid Assessment services. We accept all major credit cards (Visa, Master Card, American Express, Discover).
- 2. Student Information (You will enter information for all students attending a tuition charging school)
 - Student Social Security Number
 - Student Date of Birth
 - How much your ability to pay tuition for each student annually
 - Amount of tuition support outside of child support custodial required of non-custodial parent.
- 3. Adjusted Gross Income for Applicant and/or Co-applicant from most recent Federal Income tax return.
- 4. Nontaxable Income amount received & frequency of:
 - Child Support
 - Temporary assistance for needy families (TANF)
 - Welfare
 - Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP)
 - Tuition Support from friends/relatives/employers
 - Workers' Compensation
 - Housing Allowance (Military, Religious, Parsonage, etc)
 - Tax-Exempt Interest
 - Social Security (For all household members)
 - Any other Nontaxable income received
- 5. If you expect a decrease in income, you will need to provide reasons why and anticipated income
- 6. Monthly Expenses
 - Rent/Mortgage Payment (include principal, interest, taxes, and home insurance)
 - 2nd home Mortgage Payment
 - Monthly Home equity Loan payments
 - Year, make/model and monthly payment for all vehicles leased or owned, including those that don't
 - have a monthly payment. Do not include vehicle insurance expenses.
 - Total Credit Card Debt & minimum amounts due on statements
 - Student Loan payments for family members no longer attending college
 - Other monthly loan payments (do not include cell phone, utilities, or other living expenses)
 - Child Support payments
 - Health insurance premiums paid per month, amount and how it is paid (pre-tax payroll, direct to
 - insurance company, etc)

- 7. Annual/Yearly Expenses
 - Vehicle Insurance
 - Out-of-pocket medical expenses not paid by insurance
 - Charitable contributions
 - Number of family members attending college in fall, and your total out of pocket cost
 - Number of children you pay child/day care expenses beginning in fall, and annual expected cost
 - Number of people for whom you pay elder care expenses, and total expected cost

- Value of cash, savings, and/or checking accounts
- Value of stocks, bond investments, mutual funds, and/or certificates of deposit
