To apply, students must bring a copy of their driver's license, proof of insurance, and this completed form to the Senior High School Counseling Office to get their pass and select a parking spot. For renewal, a student must also bring their current pass to obtain a new year label.

Students will keep the same parking pass throughout their time at Lake Center but must renew it each year.

Students parking without a valid permit will receive one written warning, followed by a \$10 fine. Continued violations may result in loss of parking privileges.

Student Driver and Parking Policy

Senior High students who possess a valid driver's license may drive to school. All student drivers are expected to follow the rules below:

1. Parking Requirements

- Students must park only in the Student Parking Lot on school days.
- A valid Parking Pass is required. Passes must be purchased and displayed on the rear-view mirror at all times.
- Vehicles parked in unauthorized areas or without a visible pass may be ticketed or towed at the owner's expense.

2. Vehicle Access During School Hours

- Student drivers may not go to their vehicles during the school day, including during lunch, unless they have administrative permission.

3. Driving Conduct on Campus

- Students must drive at a very slow and safe speed, 10 MPH, while on school property.
- Music must be kept low and not audible outside the vehicle.

4. Transporting Other Students

- Student drivers may not transport other students off-campus during the school day unless written permission is provided by both a parent/guardian and school administration.

5. Early Dismissal

- Student drivers will be granted early dismissal only with a written note from a parent or guardian. Phone calls, texts, or verbal requests will not be accepted.

6. Sibling Drop-off

- Student drivers who transport younger siblings must either:
 - Drop them off in the designated car rider area, or personally escort them across traffic using crosswalks.

7. Parking Lot Behavior

- Students are not permitted to loiter or “hang out” at their vehicles before or after school.
- At no time should a male and female student be sitting together in a parked vehicle on school property.

8. Policy Violations

- Violations of any student driver or parking rules may result in suspension or revocation of parking and driving privileges.
